Provide an ongoing process analysis, coordination, and oversight; conduct independent research on best practices to assist in decision-making and mitigate challenges.

...American Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) through President Bush White House **to deliver \$750K in grants to local** communities and non-profits in Putnam County.

- Coordinated the *Croton Bay Railroad Tie Removal Project* in partnership with Metro North, the Village of Croton and Army Corps of Engineers **removing derelict railroad ties to improve safety and enhanced recreation for kayakers**.
